## Ticket to Work

Ticket to Work is a Social Security Administration program for people ages 18-64 who receive Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) or both. The goal of the program is to offer job services that will assist eligible SSI/SSDI beneficiaries to enter the workforce and gain more independence.

As an Employment Network, we can help walk you through the Ticket to Work process, offer resources to help you in your interview, and help you find a job that suits your challenges and qualifications.
